## Communication and Integration of Technology Ministry

*“So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.”*  
Romans 10:17

### PURPOSE

The communication and implementation of technology in a God-guided methodology is to support the ministries and activities of Medora Community Bible Church in such a way that technology can be utilized to further the mission of Christ's Church.

It is the belief of this ministry that technology should be available for use to assist in the presentation of God's mission but not overshadow the commission that our Lord Jesus Christ set before us as members of His Church.

### QUALIFICATIONS

Any person who has accepted Jesus Christ as their personal Savior, agrees with the doctrinal statement of the church, gives assurance of their desire to live a consistent Christian life, has received or gives assurance of their willingness to receive the ordinances, attends worship services regularly, and shows evidence of a satisfactory attitude toward the standards of this church shall be eligible to participate in the Communication and Integration of Technology Ministry of the church.

### REQUIRED SKILLS

A desire to work with technology and a willingness to learn new skills are necessary.

### ORGANIZATION

The ministry will consist of a chairperson and a flexible list of resource people based on the task at hand and the approval of the church board.

### RESPONSIBILITIES

The **Ministry Chair** will be responsible for overseeing the operation and integration of existing and new technology. Tasks will include, but not be limited to, organizing and training of resource people in the church on the approved usage of technology, presenting possible candidates to the senior pastor for approval as a Ministry resource, developing of policies and procedures for the Ministry, assuring technology is in place for church-approved activities and functions, and interfacing with the church board to keep in alignment with the church direction.

The **Ministry Resource People** will be responsible for following the procedures for the tasks to which they have been assigned (i.e. soundboard, tapes, CDs etc.).

The **Ministry** will manage or assist in the management of the following existing technologies: sound system, computer system(s), computer network, lighting (drama presentations/special events), and video integration with the sound system.

The **Ministry** will also assist in the integration of new technology as the need for such technology arises. This includes consultation for any proposal of new technology to verify the cohesive integration into the current systems.

Ongoing activities include training of resource personnel on the use of technology, overseeing the generation and distribution of tape/CD ministry, developing policies and procedures on use of technology, organizing and overseeing the technology needs of church-related activities including, but not limited to, banquets and special programs.
